

Call for Contributions

Workshop on Behavioral Welfare Economics

November 2-3, 2017 - DIW Berlin

The aim of this workshop on behavioral welfare economics is to make advances on **welfare economics based on behavioral economics models**, such as when people have non-standard preferences or biased beliefs.

The workshop will take place on **November 2-3, 2017** at the **DIW in the center of Berlin**. The workshop will start on Thursday afternoon and end on Friday evening.

The plan for this workshop is to develop ideas rather than to present finished work. Hence there will be **discussion sessions** on different topics (such as welfare analysis with social or belief-dependent preferences) that take an hour to an hour and a half and that will each be started by one or two 10-15 minute presentations by one of the external or internal participants. This presentation shall not be much more than a systematic start of the discussion and could be just the thoughts of that person or some hints that could be gathered from the literature. The list of topics is not yet fixed and depends on the contributions of the participants. In addition, if there is demand, we will allocate one session to **short paper presentations** of related papers by junior researchers.

In addition to 6-9 external participants, the workshop is open to all CRC TRR 190 members. CRC members can contribute by giving an introductory presentation to one of the topics, by a short presentation of a related paper or simply by actively engaging in the discussion.

If you want to give an introductory presentation to one of the discussion sessions, please let us know by April 30, including the topic you would like to introduce. **If you are a junior researcher (i.e., not on a permanent contract) and would like to give a short paper presentation, please also let us know by April 30** and include a copy of the paper or an extended abstract. In both cases, send an email to dirk.engelmann@hu-berlin.de.

The program will be finalized by the end of May.
