



## 2017 CESifo and CRC Conference on Behavioural Economics

## **Call for Papers**

On 27 & 28 October 2017, CESifo will hold its seventh conference in the area of Behavioural Economics, this time jointly organized with the Collaborative Research Center "Rationality and Competition" (<a href="www.rationality-and-competition.de">www.rationality-and-competition.de</a>). The purpose of the conference (which will take place in Munich) is to bring together CESifo and CRC members to present and discuss their ongoing research, and to stimulate interaction and co-operation between them. All CESifo research network members and all CRC members are invited to submit their papers, which may deal with any topic within the broad domain of behavioural and experimental economics and applications to other fields.

The keynote lectures will be delivered by **Roland Benabou** (Princeton University) and **Andrew Caplin** (New York University).

The deadline for submission of papers, or a 2-3 page abstract is 23 July, 2017.

Authors of submitted papers will be notified no later than **22 August**, **2017** whether their paper has been accepted for the conference.

CESifo and the CRC will provide accommodation, and reimburse economy travel costs for all participants with accepted papers. All papers presented at the conference will appear in the CESifo Working Paper Series. The same paper is only allowed to be submitted to one of the CESifo area conferences. Papers which are more related to the topic of other area conferences will be re-directed to the respective Area Director.

## **Distinguished CESifo Affiliate - Call for Nominations**

With the purpose of encouraging talented young scholars, CESifo has instituted the Distinguished CESifo Affiliate prize, to be awarded to the best paper presented by a young author at the CESifo Area Conference on Behavioural Economics. Candidates will be accepted from close to completion of their PhD, to no more than five years after having completed it. The same limit applies to co-authors in the case of papers with multiple authors. The criteria for the award are scientific originality, policy relevance and quality of exposition. The winning paper will appear in the CESifo Working Paper Series and the prize winner will receive €3000.

All CESifo Research Fellows are welcome to nominate candidates for the award (please note that it is not mandatory for candidates to be from these research networks). To nominate a candidate, a CESifo Research Fellow must submit the nominee's paper to Klaus Schmidt, University of Munich (klaus.schmidt@lmu.de), and Ernst Fehr (ernst.fehr@econ.uzh.ch) along with a letter explaining the motivation for the nomination. The deadline for nominations is 23 July 2017.
